

What is a zine?

A zine is pamphlet or small book, usually between 20 and 50 pages long. Our collective started this zine catalog a couple years ago in order to give prisoners a broader, more up-to-date selection of materials on radical topics such as popular history and the prison industrial complex. By ordering multiples copies of the same zine, some prisoners have used the catalog to form study groups. Be sure to let us know how many zines can be sent to you at a time, and any regulations involving photocopied materials.
